Packaging

DS Smith designs and manufactures corrugated packaging for customers across Europe. In a fragmented industry, we are able to offer our customers a pan-European solutions for their packaging needs using our network of over 170 manufacturing sites across Europe.



Recycling

DS Smith's recycling business sources used paper and OCC direct from retailers and also from traders. The fibre is principally used by our own paper mills to make recycled paper, with the remainder sold to other paper manufacturers in both Europe and globally.



Paper

DS Smith manufactures recycled paper, primarily CCM "Corrugated Case Materials", which is the paper grade used to make corrugated board. We also manufacture over 300k tonnes of other paper grades that we call "Speciality Papers".



Plastics

We design and manufacture plastic bags and taps/fitments for use in bag-in-box packaging for liquids. Our products are used for the transportation of beverages, concentrates, chemicals and pharmaceuticals; we also create a range of rigid plastic packaging.
