

What you'll need:

1 x small box for head




1 x medium box for body



3 x toilet rolls



2 x tissue boxes



1 pair of scissors



Things to decorate







2 x bowls / plates (one large, one small)







Try to keep use of paints, glues and crayons to a minimum. If using them, use child-friendly water-soluble options




Start with the small box and remove the flaps at the bottom of the box. Be careful with scissors because this robot is going to need all it's fingers.



Draw round a toilet roll for eye holes and for the ears and antennae. Then cut them out.




Push the toilet rolls into the top and side holes.



Now remove the bottom flaps from the larger box and draw round the large plate / bowl for the head and the small one for the arm holes.



Cut out the arm and head holes and then decorate.



Now pop the costume on and add tissue boxes for feet. Press the on button and watch your robot come to life. If it doesn't work straight away try turning it off and on again.
