

What you'll need:

1 x medium box for body



1 x large box for legs




1 pair of scissors





Things to decorate








Try to keep use of paints, glues and crayons to a minimum. If using them, use child-friendly water-soluble options







Start with the medium box and remove the flaps at the bottom of the box. Be careful with scissors because they're even sharper than spider's fangs!



Draw round the large plate / bowl for the head and the small one for the arm holes.



Open out the large box and draw six leg shapes, (the 7th and 8th legs are your arms). Then cut the legs out and make a slit in where they'll join the body.



Cut out the arm and head holes and make slits at the sides for the spider legs.



Slot the spider legs into the slits on the sides and push them down so they're secure. Then decorate the face.



Now pop the costume on and get ready to scare every arachnophobe you know!
